- The most recent consecutive 2 monthly statements for all bank, post office, and building society accounts held by you and if applicable, your partner.
- Proof of all Loan and Debt repayment plans, even if not being paid currently ex. Catalogues, Credit Cards, Hire Purchases
- Please provide a rent statement covering the last 12 months.
